#### From the Desk of Fr. Larry... (Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ)

I occasionally ask parishioners what they are thinking or praying about as they approach the common table to receive the Body and Blood of Christ, and what they do when they return to their seats. I rarely get immediate answers. Yes, some say they are praying; some say they are asking God for something; and many say they really aren't thinking about anything in particular - not necessarily a bad thing.

If I can suggest something, it would be to take a moment (even before we get to Mass) to ask the question: In what specific way do I need Christ to feed me today? What are my hurts, my struggles, my temptations and fears? What are my hopes and dreams? What strength, courage, hope, faith, love do I require to be the strength, courage, faith, hope and love of someone I care about? Bring these longing(s) to be fed to the altar as you are about to receive, believing that Christ himself will feed you with what you need!

A professor of mine at the seminary made this entreaty to our gathered assembly during a homily: Would that we, as we so often out of habit, nonchalantly approach the Eucharistic table, the table of sacrifice, the table of Love, to consume the Body and Blood of Christ, would that we might, instead, long for and be willing to be consumed by the love of God.

Think about that for a moment. God so loved the world that He gave His only Son. God so loves the world that God continues to give us His Son in simple gifts of bread and wine. Heaven is joined with earth. The Spirit of God has touched the elements and changed them to be spiritual food for us and, through us, sustenance for others.

This is why I encourage Eucharistic ministers to look directly in the eyes of those who are receiving from them, expressing through our own eyes God's deep love for them. As the priest, deacon, or lay minister says the words, "Body of Christ," "Blood of Christ," there are two dynamics taking place requiring our "Amen!" The first is an "Amen!" meaning I firmly believe that what you are offering me to take from you is indeed the Body and Blood of Christ. The second "Amen!" meaning "let it be so" is an affirmation of our desire for us and the minister of Holy Communion to become more fully the Body and Blood of Christ for others.

As we return to our seats after receiving the Eucharist, what do we do? Do we wait for the closing prayer and announcements? Check our watches? Or do we take the time to really ponder the great Gift that we have received? Do we ask for what we uniquely, and even specifically, desire from Christ to give us the strength we need in the coming days?

The Eucharist is an incredible gift from Jesus, His flesh and blood, soul and divinity, longing for us to believe and accept Him fully into our very flesh and spirit, to fortify and strengthen us in any way we need to walk the coming week's journey.
